# Where are we today?

No matter what happens next

The Elementary Schools will lose 6.4 positions **The Regional Schools will lose 12.1 positions** 

The Elementary Schools are asking for another \$539,408 from the Town of Amherst, a 6% increase over last year

The Regional Schools are asking for another \$152,136 from the Town of Amherst, a 4.81% increase over last year (along with additional money from Shutesbury, Leverett & Pelham)



# What's next?

The Elementary School budget goes to the Amherst Town **Manager and Town Council** 

The Regional School budget goes to the Amherst Town **Manager, Town Council and Town Meetings** 

If more money is not found The Elementary Schools will lose another 7.3 positions The Regional Schools will not have a budget if 2/4 towns fail to pass it - and the situation will be much worse




# Why is this happening?


- State-wide problem
- Charter School tuition formula siphoning money
- Many fixed costs rising faster than funding
- Changing population due to enrollment decline
